

Clarke County Youth Basketball

League BY-LAWS

General

- 1) The Clarke County Youth Basketball league (CCYB) shall be league designed not only to teach children basketball but also sportsmanship, fair play, teamwork and friendly competition.
- 2) It is the responsibility of board, coaches, gym supervisors and referees to maintain control over players, parents and fans in order for this program to run smoothly.
- 3) Each child and parent/guardian must sign a Code of Ethics. This Code explains the expected behavior during the season. Anyone who acts in direct violation of the Code may be ask to leave the gym by the supervisor. (A board review will be held for each situation)
- 4) CCYB will not tolerate any verbal, physical or sexual abuse directed towards any of its participants. Coaches or other volunteers are not permitted to go anywhere alone with a child. Parents are strongly encouraged to attend and observe practices, games and any other team activity. All allegations of any abuse will be taken seriously and reported to the proper authorities for investigative purpose. CCYB will be fully cooperative and supportive of any such investigation.

The Board

- 1) The League shall be governed by a board consisting of volunteers approved by the existing board.
- 2) Officers of the board will be elected from within.
- 3) In order for the board to have a quorum, 66% of members shall be present. Votes are passed with an agreement of a majority of present members.
- 4) The board will approve new members and elect officers at the first meeting of each season.
- 5) Officers: President, Vice President, Treasure, Player Agent, Information Officer, Girls and Boys league commissioners.
- 6) All board members must remain active within the duties of the board Meetings, Gym Supervision, Sponsors, concessions etc. Board members deemed inactive may be removed by majority vote of the board.
- 7) League rules are established and amended at boards approval.
